

Medical conditions treatable at Lapham Medical Clinic

- URI (Upper respiratory infection)
- Sore Throat
- Earaches
- Mild Asthma- no active exacerbation
- Minor allergic reactions- no lip swelling, tongue swelling, or difficulty breathing
- Sinusitis
- Rash
- Pink Eye- no eye injury
- Allergies
- Minor MVA (motor vehicle accident)- no radiographic imaging needed
- Mild sprains and strains - no radiographic imaging needed
- Visible FB (foreign body) removal – ear, nose, and skin
- Mild GI (gastrointestinal) symptoms- no concerning signs of dehydration or abdominal pain
- Back pain without neurologic symptoms- no numbness, tingling, loss of bowel or bladder control, new or unusual leg weakness
- Neck pain without neurologic symptoms - no numbness, tingling, loss of bowel or bladder control, new or unusual leg or arm weakness
- Back/neck pain not related to a fall or direct trauma
- UTI (urinary tract infection) symptoms without concern for pyelonephritis (kidney infection)
- STD symptoms or known exposure
- Suture and staple removal
- Minor burns
- Insect bites
- Minor laceration repair
- Minor cutaneous abscess needing I&D (incision and drainage)- no fever or extensive cellulitis
- Ingrown toenail- including removal
- Paronychia (finger or toe nail infection)- Incision and Drainage
- Minor headache
- Minor head injury- no loss of consciousness, repetitive speech, somnolence (excessive drowsiness), persistent vomiting, signs of skull fracture, seizures, blood thinners
- Dental pain

- Cerumen (ear wax) impaction
- Gout
- Need for pregnancy test without symptoms of abdominal pain or vaginal bleeding
- Medication refills- not including psychiatric medications or controlled medications such as narcotics or benzodiazepines. Medication refills through your primary care physician are recommended but we understand there are circumstances that may result in lack of access to get prescribed medications refilled
