

Conditions not treatable at Lapham Medical Clinic

Chest Pain/EKG-including Congestive Heart Failure and arrhythmias
Severe abdominal pain
Anaphylaxis
Gastrointestinal Bleed
Pregnancy Complications
Poisoning/Drug overdose
Suicidal Ideation or other mental health emergencies requiring Involuntary Commitment to a psychiatric facility
Head injury with loss of consciousness, on blood thinners, any concern they may need CT scan
CPR in progress
Post resuscitation
Respiratory distress
Deep Vein Thrombosis
Pulmonary Embolism
Eye trauma
MVC with need for imaging
Joint dislocations
Non-visible foreign body removal
Pelvic exam
Gastrointestinal symptoms concerning for dehydration or need for CT scan
Back and neck pain with neurological symptoms or due to direct trauma or a fall
Stroke symptoms
Dizziness in an elderly patient
New onset severe headache
Seizures
Paralysis
Electric shock
Breast infection or abscess
Peri rectal abscess/hemorrhoids
Narcotics prescriptions
Benzodiazepine prescriptions
Psychiatric medication prescriptions
Any controlled substance prescription
Procedural sedation
Hormone treatment
Testicular pain
Flank pain not related to muscular strain
Septic joint (joint infection)
Obvious bone fractures
Visual changes

Major lacerations- significant muscle tissue destruction, bone fragments visible, concern for tendon or ligamentous injury

Hypothermia

Syncope (passing out)

Heat exhaustion/stroke

Severe anemia

Cancer patients with fever

Immunocompromised with fever

Infant less than 90 days old with fever

Carbon Monoxide exposure/poisoning

Complication of device, implant or graft

Urinary retention

Substance abuse disorders/detox

Routine vaccinations

Rabies Immune globulin and vaccine
